## How to edit your hunter report from your online account

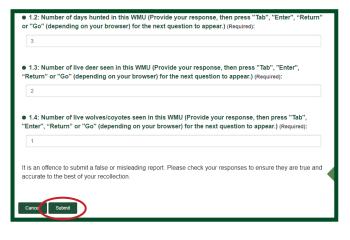
All hunters that purchase or are issued a tag to hunt elk, deer, bear, wild turkey, wolf/coyote or a moose licence must complete a mandatory hunter report even if they did not participate in the hunt or harvest an animal.

Hunter reports must be completed from your online account or by calling the automated telephone line at 1-800-288-1155. For step-by-step instructions on how to submit your hunter report, please reference the **How to submit your hunter report** tip sheet.

If you have submitted a hunter report and need to make a change or add additional information to an already completed report, you can edit your hunter report only online through the Fish and Wildlife Licensing Service up until the reporting deadline.

Follow these steps to edit your submitted hunter report:





## Step 1

Visit www.huntandfishontario.com and select "Submit Hunter Report," then log in to your online account. If you haven't already set up your online account, please reference the How to create an online account tip sheet.

## Step 2

Once logged into your account, the hunter reporting page will display all "Open Reports," You can select "View" to see your submitted answers or select the "Edit" button next to the report you wish to change.

Update your hunter report and select "Submit" to save your changes. If you do not select "Submit," your original report will be used.

If the edit and view buttons are unavailable, you have not successfully submitted your hunter report, select "Provide Report" to start your report; or the species deadline has passed and you will not be able to edit your submitted hunter report.

Did you know how important it is to submit your hunter report? The information you provide helps us to better understand wildlife populations and we use it to make decisions about harvest levels and tag allocations.
