Erratum: Incorporating lakes within the river discontinuum: longitudinal changes in ecological characteristics in stream-lake networks**Nicholas E. Jones**

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On page 1357 of the published article, the final sentence of the caption for Fig. 8 was truncated. The caption should read as follows:

Fig. 8. (a) Trellis and (b) dendritic network drainage patterns and respective basin shapes illustrate how basin shape influences lake effects. A single lake in the midreaches of a trellis network may alter the ecological characteristics (e.g., flow regime) without dilution from large neighbouring network branches for many kilometres. In contrast, the same placement of a lake in the dendritic basin will lead to ecological changes that are soon diluted by tributaries.

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
